What is genetic testing?

- Genetic testing identifies changes in a person's genes and can determine whether a person has a predisposition to certain diseases or health conditions. Genetic testing can also help identify the type of medication, or even the dose of medication, that is best for an individual.

Why should I get a genetic test?

- By knowing your genetic risk for certain diseases and your reaction to medications, you and your physician will have the ability to make more informed decisions about modifying your diet, lifestyle, health care, and medication intake to help you diminish those risks. For example, depending on your results, you could then potentially decide to be screened for a disease, or disease precursors, at an earlier age and may even schedule your screenings more frequently.

Why Cardiac DNA Insight™?

- The Cardiac DNA Insight™ can identify risk factors that are associated with an increased risk to develop various heart conditions, such as atrial fibrillation, or diseases that usually develop later in life, such as coronary artery disease. Someone with an inherited genetic risk factor may have an increased chance of developing a disease, although this does not necessarily mean that the person will get the disease.
- This laboratory test analyzes your blood or saliva for your unique genetic markers that influence a broad range of heart-related health conditions, including ApoE, HDL and LDL cholesterol levels, risk for developing hypertension, and myocardial infarction. Cardiac DNA Insight also examines eight classes of medications that affect the cardiovascular system, including statins, beta-blockers, ACE inhibitors, and hormone therapies.
